

# Specialty Type Soybeans

## New for 2012:

Revenue Protection now available with use of a Harvest Price based on spread between contract price and Projected Price

## Program Change 2011:

Specialty soybeans can be insured as Yield Protection  
Must be grown under contract

All Others (conventional) soybeans insured as Revenue Protection.  
All soybeans in county must (still) be insured

## Varieties:

- (882) Large Seeded Food Grade: minimum 2,520 seeds/lb
- (883) Small Seeded Food Grade: minimum 3,780 seeds/lb
- (884) Low Linolenic Acid: oil usually  $\leq 3\%$  acid
- (885) Low Saturated Fat: oil usually  $\leq 8\%$  fat
- (886) High Protein:  $\geq 42\%$  for dry matter,  $\geq 36.5\%$  at 13% moisture
- (128) All Other Food Grades

Can be grown for seed also

## Coverage:

Can be at different coverage level than your other soybeans  
Can be at different unit structure than your other soybeans  
No Enterprise Units or CAT coverage allowed

## Replanting:

Not practical unless production can be delivered per contract  
Options: indemnity, plant another crop-specialty type-conventional

## Price Election:

Contracted price, not to exceed the following limit factors:

- (882) Large Seeded Food Grade: 1.5 times YP price
- (883) Small Seeded Food Grade: 1.3 times YP price
- (884) Low Linolenic Acid: 1.15 times YP price
- (885) Low Saturated Fat: 1.15 times YP price
- (886) High Protein: 1.15 times YP price
- (128) All Other Food Grades: 1.15 times YP price
